Sub: Provisions and Regulations under Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006.

Madam,

In response to your letter mentioned under reference it is to inform that under Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, Rules, 2011 and Regulations, 2011, the Food Business Operators (here SHGs) who have annual turnover not exceeding Rs. 12 Lakh will be treated as Petty Food Business Operators and fall under Registration and those who have turnover exceeding 12 Lakh will be treated as Licensee. The process of Registration and Licenses has been laid down in Food Safety and Standards (Licensing and Registration of Food Businesses) Regulations, 2011.

Licensing and Registration within the Railway Area fall under the purview of Central Licensing. In West Bengal there are three Railway Zones, viz. Eastern Zone, North Frontier Zone and South Eastern Railway Zone. The Designated Officers of the concerned Zone is entrusted for issuance License and Registration.

In the Districts, the Dy. Chief Medical Officer of Health - II (Designated Officer) of the concerned Districts and Designated Officer for Kolkata Municipal Corporation are the licensing authorities and the Food Safety Officers are the registering authorities for Food Business Operators within concerned jurisdiction.

For filing application for License/Registration SHGs will have to move to the concerned offices of Designated Officers as mentioned above.
